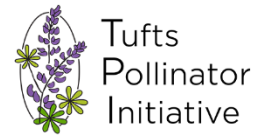




Top 10 shrubs for native bees

1. Pollen and nectar resources for specialist and at-risk bumble bees and solitary bees
2. Shelter, nesting sites and nesting materials like leaves that bees need to complete their life cycles
3. Food for insects like butterflies and other native wildlife
